



Year 3 Curriculum Map

Autumn 1 2024 - 2025



English

Our fiction unit this half term is folk tales. We will be reading and responding to different folk talks, such as The Green Children and The Greenling before story mapping and orally rehearsing our own folk tale. Our key skills this half term will be using inverted commas for direct speech, and writing complex sentences using when, before and after.

Maths

This half term we will start with Place Value, Addition and Subtraction. We will look at place value numbers up to 1000. We will use different strategies for mental addition and subtraction. The children will also cover length and perimeter and statistics this half term.

Science

The science topic this half term is Healthy Humans. We will be focusing on; being healthy, different food groups, the importance of each food group and we will be researching healthy recipes.

PE

Mr Carr will be teaching Target Games in PE on Tuesday and Fridays. Helen will also be teaching Dance on Thursday mornings.

History

This term, the children will be studying the changes to life in Britain from the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. Children will also have first hand experience of what it was like to live in the Stone Age through an outdoor workshop.

Art

This half term we will be looking at the work of artist LS Lowry. They will be looking at examples of his paintings before creating their own Lowry style piece of art.

PSHE

This half term is all about belonging to community. The children will consider the value of laws and rules, rights of children, freedoms and responsibilities.

Music

Music will be taught by Mrs Spall from the Lancashire Music Service on Mondays.

French

This will start with getting to know you, colours and numbers. the children will learn how to ask and answer about simple feelings, count from 0-11 and know six colours.

Computing

The first computing unit this year is Email. The children will be using 2Emails on purple mash as a safe space to learn about how to open, respond and send emails.

RE

In the Harvest unit, the children will be focusing on the value thankfulness. We will look at other religions and make links with practices within school, community, their own lives and the wider world.
