# PE Days

Regular reading not only strengthens vocabulary and comprehension but also helps foster a lifelong love of books. There are lots of free eBooks here <https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/free-ebooks/>. Also remember children can borrow library books from school and from Burnley library. In addition, we expect children to **practise their times tables daily**. A solid grasp of multiplication facts is essential for success in many areas of maths, and regular practice at home helps reinforce what is being taught in school.
