



Year 2 Curriculum Map

Autumn 2 2024 - 2025



English- This unit this term is called 'Traditional Tale with a twist'. Children will write letters in the form of characters from classic fairy tales and create their own twisted fairy tale story. Children will be writing a fairy tale review and writing a diary entry in the role of wolf.

Maths- This half term we will be learning different strategies for multiplying numbers as well as sorting numbers, fractions and money. Children will also look at time and how we can use a clock to tell the time. Children will be continuing to learn the 10 and 5 times tables.

Science- In Science we will be finding out what humans need to survive as well as what we need to stay healthy, covering food, exercise, hygiene and medicine.

PE- Our units this half term are gymnastics and invasion games.

Geography- In Geography this half term we will be exploring our local area. Children will take a walk around the local area and learn how to use map directions as well as learning how to read a compass. Children will learn how to use geographical language when giving directions.

DT- This half term, children will be making finger puppets as a part of our school enterprise week. Children will learn how to do a running stitch as well as learn how to cut fabric. Children will have the opportunity to buy their finger puppets at the enterprise fair.

PSHE- This half term we will be learning about 'Money and Work'. This unit covers what is money and what forms you might find it in as well as how people might earn money.

Music- In music this half term, children will be learning all the songs for the school production of 'A Wiggly Nativity'.

Read, Write Inc - Children have been re-assessed and placed into their new groups and will continue to have daily guided reading lessons. RWI homework will continue to be sent out on school ping weekly.

Computing- In computing we will be completing the 'Questioning' unit on Purple Mash. This unit is designed to help children learn about the importance of phrasing questions and that certain data handling resources are limited in the answers they can provide.

RE- This term children will be exploring all about the meaning and importance of Christmas. Children will learn about the story of Christmas and how the angel spread the good news. Later in the term, Pink Class will also be involved in the school production of 'A Wiggly Nativity'.
