



Year 2 Curriculum Map

Spring 2 2024 - 2025



English- This half term, children will be creating their own piece of persuasive text. Children will use what they learnt from their trips to Blackpool Zoo and Martin Mere to write a persuasive leaflet. Children will also be looking at the story 'The Wind in the Willows'. Children will be writing an animal adventure story and creating a poem.

Maths- This half term we will cover money, multiplication and division, length, addition and subtraction, 2D and 3D shape, fractions, position and direction. We will also be continuing to practice our 5 times tables.

Science- We will be exploring the properties of materials and the different uses these materials have in everyday life. We will identify and compare the suitability of a variety of materials, finding out how materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching and how some materials can be found naturally.

PE- This half term, children will continue to build on their gymnastic skills as well as practicing some fundamental movement skills with bounce balls.

History- This half term Pink Class are looking at significant black people with a particular focus on the cricket legend Learie Constantine. We will be exploring in what ways he was significant.

DT- In DT, we will be looking at how to make a healthy pizza with a particular focus on how we can make sure we have a balanced diet. Children will be making their own pizza.

PSHE- This term, our unit is called 'Relationships'. Children will be learning what a good relationship looks like and how people should be treated in order to have a good relationship with them. We will also be learning about self-image and identify.

Music- In Music, we are learning a song called 'Zootime'.

RWI- Children have been re-assessed and been placed into their new groups. Weekly homework videos will be sent out for children to watch.

Computing- This half term, children will be looking at 'Spreadsheets'. Children will collect data and produce a graph to demonstrate totals and use a spreadsheet for money calculations.

RE- Our unit is all about Easter with a particular focus on how symbols can help us to understand the story of Easter.
