



Year 2 Curriculum Map

Autumn 1 2024 - 2025



English- Pink Class will be exploring the book 'The Way Home for Wolf' by Rachel Bright. Children will be writing their own character descriptions as well as creating a non-fiction animal poster about wolves

Maths- This term children will be exploring methods of counting, multiplication and sorting. They will be learning an effective method when finding fractions of amounts. Children will practice their 10 times tables.

Science- Children will enjoy exploring 'living things and their habitats'. This includes looking for microhabitats within the school grounds. Children will also be investigating the different signs of Autumn.

PE - In PE we will do one lesson a week on invasion games and another on the Fundamental Movement Skills. We will also have a weekly dance lesson.

History- This half term, children will be learning all about a Victorian seaside and comparing it to the seaside now. Children will ask questions, look at different artifacts and make judgements on their findings.

Art- Children will be exploring the artist Henri Rousseau. Children will be retrieving their own leaves from outside and completing observational drawing using techniques such as shading and sketching.

PSHE- This term, Pink Class will be looking at 'living in the wider world'. Each week children will also complete a Picture News discussion about important stories that are happening in the world

Music- In Music we will be using the Charanga Music Service. Our song is called 'Hands, feet and heart'.

Computing- Children will be learning how to create pictures using the Purple Mash tool. Children will also be investigating how to stay safe online and how to recognise good and bad online relationships.
