



Year 2 Curriculum Map

Summer 1 2024 - 2025



English- This half term our learning is based on the book 'The Wind in the Willows'. Children will be writing their own animal story and a poem.

Maths- This half term children will continue to develop their place value and statistics knowledge, addition and subtraction knowledge and fractions knowledge. Children will also begin to learn their 2 times tables.

Science- In Science we will be learning about plants and how they grow. Children will be investigating plant seeds and planting their own seeds to grow at home.

PE- In PE children will learn athletic skills and continue to build on their fundamental movement skills.

Geography- In Geography, we will be learning all about Serekunda which is in The Gambia. Children will explore what life is like and investigate human and physical features of Serekunda.

Art- We will be studying the work of William Morris. Morris is famous for designing wallpaper. Children will create their own design that will be printed for wallpaper.

PSHE- Children will take part in a Picture News lesson each week as well as learning all about health and well-being.

Music- In Music, children will be learning the 'Friendship song'.

RWI- Children were re-assessed before the holidays and have now been placed into their new groups. Children will be sent weekly homework to complete.

Computing- This half term children will be using Purple Mash to make music on a computer.

RE- This half term we will be learning all about the Church. Children will visit St Peter's church and discover the most importance aspects of the Church. Children will also be studying other religious buildings from other religions.
