<p>Creative: We will be thinking a lot about colours this term whilst completing our artist study on Kandinsky. Go for a 'Creative Colour Hunt' walk and take photos of as many different colours you can see. Could you find different shades of the same colour? e.g. dark green leaves and light green leaves on the trees. Send the photos to Miss Franklin to help us create our 'Natural Colour Board'.</p>	<p>Literacy: Have a go at making up your own story. Who will the characters be? What will the setting be? What will happen at the beginning, in the middle and at the end? After you've made up your story, you could have a go at writing it. Bring in your writing to WOW us!</p>	<p>Cooking: Our topic this term is 'Once Upon A Time..' so, naturally, we shall be looking at lots of fairy tales. One well known traditional tale is Little Red Riding Hood. She bakes for her Grandma. Have a go at doing some baking with your family. It could be a whole cake, cupcakes or even bread. Send a photo to Miss Franklin to share your baking creation.</p>
<p>Geography: Draw a map of the walk you go on for your Creative Colour Hunt. Can you add any special features? e.g. did you see a pond? Or a park? Bring in your map to share with us.</p>	<p>Maths: We are thinking about 'time' as part of this term's Maths learning. We will be concentrating on sequencing the days of the week. Can you make a little calendar for yourself on the sheet attached? You could draw or write in each box what happens on those days. e.g. which days are school days? If you go to any clubs or swimming etc. which days are they on?</p>	<p>RE: In RE this term we are thinking about 'Special People'. Please email me or send your child in with a photo of them with someone who is special to them. This could be a family member, or a Police Officer, Vicar, Imam etc.</p>
