



EYFS Curriculum Map

Summer 1 2024 - 2025



Literacy

In **Literacy** we shall be reading the book 'The Queens Hat', writing and innovating simple sentences from the story. We shall also be reading 'Mr Gumpy's Motor Car' and learning about the use of speech bubbles.

Maths

In **Maths** we will be learning to compare groups of objects, sharing objects equally into halves and quarters (between 2 and 4). We will also learn about measuring distance, height, weight and volume.

Science

In **Science** we will be learning about Earth and Space. We will discover a little bit about each of the planets, the moon and stars. And how the Sun determines the seasons of the year.

PE

In **PE** we shall continue to develop our fundamental movement skills, completing the unit 'Rosie's Walk'.

Topic Time

In EYFS our **Geography/History** learning is completed during **Topic Time**. Our topic this term is "All Around The World". We will be learning about transport from the past and present and what is appropriate for travelling to different places. We will look at how we travel around Burnley. We will also be learning a little bit about London.

Expressive Arts & Design

In **EAD** this term we shall be working together to build London landmarks, make a space picnic and many more creative activities.

PSED

In **PSED** time, we will be continuing our learning about road safety. We will be learning how to build a 'Growth Mindset'. We will also be learning about how to assess our own risk, inside and outside to make safe and sensible choices.

Music

In **Music**, we will be exploring musical instruments, the sounds they make and exploring how to adjust the volume of the sound. We will explore the sound real life objects make and compare this to musical instruments.

RE

In **RE** we will be completing the 'Special Places' unit. We will learn that Christians worship in a Church, Muslims worship in a temple and Hindus worship in a Temple/Mandir. We will learn that people think places are special for different reasons and think about places that are special for us. We will learn that some people of faith take off their shoes before entering a place of worship.
