Reading at Home

- From your child's first full week in school (16th September 2024) we shall send all children home with a reading book.
- For the first few weeks we will be sending books which do not contain words. This is so that you can help your child develop their story language and spend time looking at details in the illustrations.
- Once we have learnt the first 10 sounds in RWI, if your child is ready, we shall send home a Sound Blending book.



Reading Books

- Reading books will be changed once a week. We like to give the children plenty of time with each book to encourage confidence and fluency in reading.
- Book changing day will usually coincide with PE day (there may be the odd occasion when book changing day may have to change for a week).
- We will read with all children at least once a week, but there is no set day for this, so please keep your child's Reading Pack in their bookbags.
- Reading Journals are checked weekly to see how often children are reading at home. This is recorded and we shall send this information home at the end of each term. In Reception it is crucial that children read every day to help support their early literacy development, we would like them to have at least 5 reads recorded in their journals each week.



Home Learning

- Every Wednesday I shall send you a School PING message with links to RWI videos for your child to watch at home.
- Once children split into their sound groups the links will be different for each group. Whenever groups change I shall send you a School PING message to let you know which group your child is in.
- Videos will be active from the Wednesday sent until the following Monday evening. These videos will guide children through how to complete their writing homework in their homework books.
- Each half term you shall also receive a Homework Matrix with up to 6 optional home learning activities you may wish to complete with your child.




100% Attendance

- Children need to attend school every day.
- Children are expected to have as close to 100% attendance as possible.
- Missing even one day of school can set them back two or three days in learning as for example, they could miss the introduction to a topic or new concept in Maths.
- 1 day absence is 1 RWI sound.
