PE

PE day is WEDNESDAY.

Children need to wear their PE kit to school:

- ❖ A White T-Shirt
- ❖ School Jumper
- ❖ Black Shorts/ Leggings/ Joggers
- ❖ Black Trainers/ Velcro Pumps

To partake in PE children must be in a PE Kit and children must not be wearing earrings.



Reading at Home

- From your child's first full week in school (15th September 2025) we shall send all children home with a reading book.
- For the first few weeks we will be sending books which do not contain words. This is so that you can help your child develop their story language and spend time looking at details in the illustrations.
- Once your child has securely learnt the first 10 sounds in RWI, we shall send home a Sound Blending book.



Reading Books

- Reading books will be changed once a week. We like to give the children plenty of time with each book to encourage confidence and fluency in reading.
- Book changing day will usually be a Monday (there may be the odd occasion when book changing day may have to change for a week).
- We will read with all children at least once a week, but there is no set day for this, so please keep your child's Reading Pack in their bookbags.
- Reading Journals are checked weekly to see how often children are reading at home. This is recorded and we shall send this information home at the end of each term. In Reception it is crucial that children read every day to help support their early literacy development, we would like them to have at least 5 reads recorded in their journals each week.

- Reading Journal
- Homework Book & Pencil
- Name Writing Sheet, Wipeboard Pen & Rubber

*wipeboard pen only to be used on name writing sheet, not in homework book



Home Learning

We have changed the way we are doing homework this year.

- We shall send two sound videos a week and the handwriting videos for those sounds.
- Please watch the handwriting videos and encourage your child to independently complete their handwriting in their homework books in pencil. Please supervise them and ensure they are using the formation shown in the videos. Please do not do the writing for them.
- We shall stop this form of homework around Christmas time, when most children will be bringing home lengthier books, so that children have more time to be reading these everyday at home.



100% Attendance

- Children need to attend school every day.
- Children are expected to have as close to 100% attendance as possible.
- Missing even one day of school can set them back two or three days in learning as for example, they could miss the introduction to a topic or new concept in Maths.



Illness

- Children need to attend school every day.
- We understand that illness happens, so here are some guidelines:
 - If your child has a consistent fever of over 38* they need to stay off school until their temperature returns to normal.
 - If your child has been sick or had loose bowels, they need to remain off school for 48 hours after their last vomiting or loose bowel episode.
- Children can come into school with a cough or a cold.
- Children can come into school if they are on medication. If this is a medication that is required 4x a day, we can administer this in school. Only medications prescribed by the doctor (with label) can be administered.




Teeth Brushing

- We are now a Supervised Brushing School.
- Children will brush their teeth in school while supervised by the adults.

If your child is under five...

1. Register your child online at www.coolmilk.com/register.
2. If you register before 5pm on a Tuesday, your child will start receiving milk from the following week.
3. Your child will start to gain all the nutritional benefits from a daily serving of chilled milk in the classroom.

Pay for your child's school milk

If your child is over five...

1. Register your child online at www.coolmilk.com/register.
2. Milk usually costs around £14 a term. By registering online, you'll be able to make a payment straightaway. If your payment is received by 5pm on a Tuesday, your child will receive milk the following week.
3. Your child will start to gain all the nutritional benefits from a daily serving of chilled milk in the classroom.
