



EYFS Curriculum Map

Spring 2 2024 - 2025



Literacy

In **Literacy** we shall be reading the book 'Surprising Sharks' and learning how to label pictures. We shall also be reading 'Oi Frog' learning about rhyming and creating our own rhyming sentences.

In our 'Talk Through Stories' sessions we shall be looking at the books: 'Rainbow Fish', 'Elmer' and 'Farmer Duck'.

Maths

In **Maths** we will be learning to complete simple additions and subtractions, halving and doubling, and developing our number sense.

Science

In **Science** we will be learning about animals and their habitats. We shall learn about life cycles of animals, where different types of animals live and why, and look at animals we have in our local environment.

PE

In **PE** we will continue to develop our fundamental movement skills, completing the unit 'Minibeasts'.

Topic Time

In EYFS our **Geography/History** learning is completed during **Topic Time**. Our topic this term is 'Animal Antics'. We will be learning about the world, beginning to know how the world is made up of countries and continents, land and sea/ocean. We will be comparing and contrasting different environments.

Expressive Arts & Design

In **EAD** this term we shall be making cards for someone very special in our lives ready to celebrate them on 30th March... any guesses?

We all also be completing several different creative activities around the different animals we are learning about.

PSED

In **PSED** time, we will be continuing our learning about road safety. We will be learning how to build our independence and develop a 'have a go' attitude. We will develop a deeper understanding of our emotions and how to show empathy to others when they are not feeling good.

Music

In **Music**, we will be completing two units called 'Pets & Other Animals' and 'Chinese New Year'. We shall be thinking about the pitch, pulse, tempo, any silence in a piece, the duration and timbre of a piece of music and learning a new piece of musical vocabulary, "pentatonic".

RE

In **RE** we will be completing the 'Easter' unit. We will learn how Christians believe Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey on Palm Sunday, he died on a cross on Good Friday and then on Easter Day he rose from the dead and is alive today. We will develop our understanding that, for Christians, Easter is the most important time in the Church calendar and the basis of the Christian faith.
