Autumn 2 2024 - 2025



Literacy

In **Literacy** we shall be learning about the story 'Kipper's Birthday' and beginning to learn to write birthday cards, lists and invitations.

In our 'Talk Through Stories' sessions we shall be looking at the books: 'The Scarecrows' Wedding', 'The Bear and The Piano' & 'Stick Man'.

Maths

In **Maths** we will be learning about the numbers 5 to 10. We will think about different ways to represent these numbers, practice counting using 1-1 correspondance and begin to learn what numbers we can add together to make these numbers.

Science

In **Science** we will be learning about forces and light. We shall learn how things move using wind and water. We will also begin learning about shadows and rainbows.

PE

In **PE** will shall continue to develop our fundamental movement skills, completing the unit 'How To Catch A Star'.

Topic Time

In EYFS our **Geography/History** learning is completed during **Topic Time**. Our topic this term is 'Let's Celebrate!' We shall be thinking about lots of different celebrations and festivals across our diverse world.

Expressive Arts & Design

In **EAD** this term we shall be creating lots of pictures and representations of the different festivals of light we will learn about.

During 'Enterprise Week', in December, we shall design, bake and decorate our own Gingerbread Men.

PSED

In **PSED** time we continue to understand and follow the school rules and routines. We will be learning about how to stay safe next to the road and in the car. We will be learning how best to solve conflicts with our friends.

Music

In **Music**, we will be completing two units called 'The Weather and The Seasons' & 'Maestro and The Christmas Tree'. We shall be thinking about the pitch, pulse, tempo and duration of a piece of music.

RE

In **RE** we will be completing the 'I Am Special' unit. We will then move on to complete the unit around 'Christmas'. When completing the 'I Am Special' unit we will discover how Christians believe humans were made by God and are all unique, special and loved. When learning about 'Christmas' we shall begin to understand that Christmas is when Christians celebrate Jesus' birthday. We will also learn about the Hindu festival of light, Diwali.
