



EYFS Curriculum Map

Spring 1 2024 - 2025



Literacy

In **Literacy** we shall be reading the book 'Superworm' and then learning and adapting the repeated refrain. We shall also be learning (to perform) the nursery rhyme 'Miss Polly Had A Dolly'.

In our 'Talk Through Stories' sessions we shall be looking at the books: 'Burglar Bill', 'Cops & Robbers' and 'One Snowy Night'.

Maths

In **Maths** we will be learning to compare groups of numbers, partition a whole number, counting teen numbers, completing simple additions and exploring length, height, width, mass/weight & capacity/volume.

Science

In **Science** we will be learning about sound. We shall learn how to focus our listening, identify the source of a sound and how we can make sounds using different objects.

PE

In **PE** we shall continue to develop our fundamental movement skills, completing the unit 'Rumble In The Jungle'.

We shall also continue with our **Dance** sessions this term.

Topic Time

In EYFS our **Geography/History** learning is completed during **Topic Time**. Our topic this term is 'Real Life Superheroes'. We will be learning all about the emergency services and how they help us, as well as everyday heroes and the role they play in our lives.

Expressive Arts & Design

In **EAD** this term we shall be completing a big junk modelling project, making emergency vehicles. We will look at details of emergency vehicles and then build using recycling, cover to make sturdy and then decorate our models, ensuring we add the details we have noticed.

PSED

In **PSED** time, we will be learning about how to stay safe next to the road and in the car. We will be learning how best to look after our bodies and stay healthy. We shall also be thinking about how we can show empathy to others.

Music

In **Music**, we will be completing two units called 'People Who Help Us'. We shall be thinking about the pitch, pulse, tempo, any silence in a piece and the duration and timbre of a piece of music.

RE

In **RE** we will be completing the 'Prayer' unit. We will learn how Christians believe Jesus taught people to pray. We will understand that in many religions prayer is form of communication used for different reasons and expressed in a variety of ways. We will learn that Muslims use a prayer mat to create a clean space to pray and stop pray at 5 special times a day.
