

Curriculum Overview Spring Two - Gold Class

Literacy - In literacy, we will be continuing our work on William Shakespeare, using Macbeth as our stimulus. We will be writing some poetry, then creating an hybrid text on The Globe Theatre. When we have finished this, we will move onto a new novel called Rooftoppers.

Maths - During this half term, we will be looking at negative numbers, ratio and proportion, volume and revising the four operations and shapes.

Science - Our unit this half term is microorganisms. We will be looking at the different types of germs, how germs spread and creating our own germs. We will be looking at various scientists and how they have contributed to modern medicine and carrying out a range of investigations.

RE - Our unit this half term is The Exodus. We will be looking at the story of Moses and how this relates to the festival of Passover. We will be inviting Father Andrew into class to show us the artifacts that are used in the Eucharist service.

Computing - This half term we will be looking at, then writing our own text adventures.

PSHE - The theme for this half term is Relationships. We will be looking at what makes a relationship safe and how we can show respect for ourselves and others.

Geography - We will start by finishing off our unit The World in our School which involves looking at our different heritages.

History - Once we have finished our geography unit, we will be moving onto Vikings where we will be investigating the big question of whether the Vikings were really brutal invaders.
