PE

English

Our novel for the full term is The Nowhere Emporium. However, this half term will focus on the characters and atmosphere and descriptive images of the story. We will be writing in role, creating poetry and writing our own version of the story.

Maths

This half term our focus is on place value (including decimals), algebra and sequences, addition, subtraction and multiplication. We will also carry out work on our times tables and mental calculation skills.

Science

Our topic this half term is Evolution and Inheritance. We will be looking at how fossils inform our knowledge of how plants and animals have evolved. We will also be looking at which characteristics are inherited and examining the work of Charles Darwin.

PE

PE will be taught by Mr Carr on Monday afternoons and Friday mornings.

History

This half term, our history topic is Black History. The topic is called A Lancashire Slave Ship called Hope and we will be looking at slavery, racial equality and trading.

Art

This half term, we are focussing on printing. We will be looking at repeated patterns in wallpaper and fabric, moving onto how these are replicated from nature. We will create our own repeating patterns using different printing techniques.

PSHE

Our overall theme is Living in the Wider World. We will be looking at how we value diversity; challenge discrimination and investigate stereotypes.

Music

Mrs Spall will continue to teach singing and recorder on Monday mornings.

French

Mr Rainbird will teach French on Monday afternoons. This half term focuses on every day life. The children will revisit everyday life, learn how to ask and give the correct time and also learn how to describe their daily routines.

Computing

Our first unit will focus on blogging and our online safety sessions will focus on online relationships.

RE

Our topic this half term is Life as a Journey. We will be looking at the journey of Jesus, and the importance of pilgrimages in different religions, comparing and contrasting these.
