



Year 4 Curriculum Map

Autumn 2 2024 - 2025

English

We will be looking at fairy tales based around the story 'Rumaysa.' We will read and learn the story, looking at the characters and the plot of the story whilst learning further grammar skills including fronted adverbials and continuing to consolidate previous grammar skills

Maths

We be looking at multiplication where we will learn different strategies for mental multiplication and a written method for multiplication. We will then be using mental strategies for division and the chunking method for written division. Then we will be practicing telling the time on an analogue clock and looking at shape.

RE

Our next unit of learning will be looking towards Christmas and the symbolism of Light. Jesus is called the 'Light of the World', we will think about what this means and how we can be a 'light' to those around us. We will look at the life of people who brought 'light' to those around them. .

Science

Our topic this half term is 'Sound'. We will learn about how sound is made and how we can change the pitch and volume of sound, thinking about the scientific explanation behind it. We will learn new vocabulary to use when explaining our findings and we will carry out an investigation into sound.

History/Geography

We will spend the first few weeks finishing off our topic on Ancient Egypt. We will then move on to Geography where we will study another region in the UK, the Lake District.

DT/Art

We will be finishing off our topic on electrical systems before moving onto our first Art topic. In Art, we will be studying the artist Vincent Van Gogh, looking at some of his paintings, thinking about features and techniques he used and trying to re-create some of these ourselves.

Computing

After starting the half term thinking about online safety, we will then go on to learn about and use spreadsheets. How to input data and a real life situation in which to use it.

PSHE

We will look at the theme of Belonging to a community. Alongside this each half term will begin with looking at an aspect of online safety in computing and PSHE.

PE

In PE children we will be learning about Invasion games-Basketball and will continues with their swimming lessons.
