Coaches Ina and Jahn were blown away by the energy the children brought to the sessions, everyone wanted to give throughout and support each other.

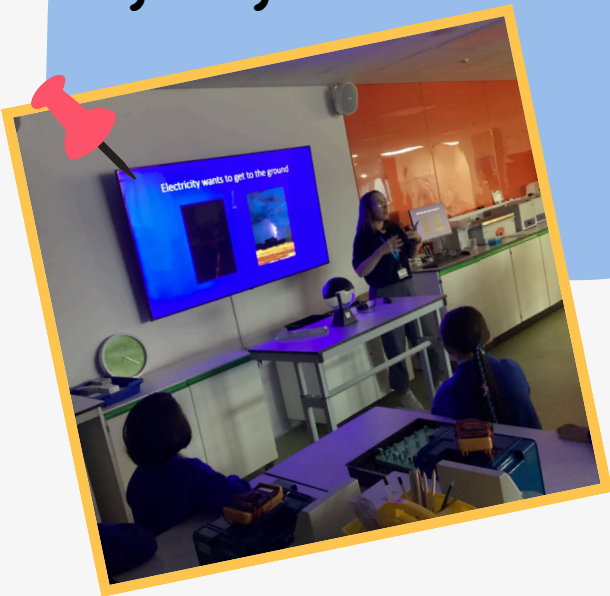


Football Tournament

Young Scientist Centre

This week Year 4 visited the Young Scientist Centre in UCLAN, Preston, where they took part in an electrifying experiments day. They discussed what electricity actually is, how it is made and what a circuit is before having a go at creating some themselves. They used the various equipment to create a working circuit and experiment with adding more bulbs and cells to it to see what would happen. They used a multimeter to measure the voltage running through the circuit and spent the afternoon trying to crack a code, using the circuits to help. They also got to use a Tesla ball, exploring electricity and lightning.
