OTTO Club

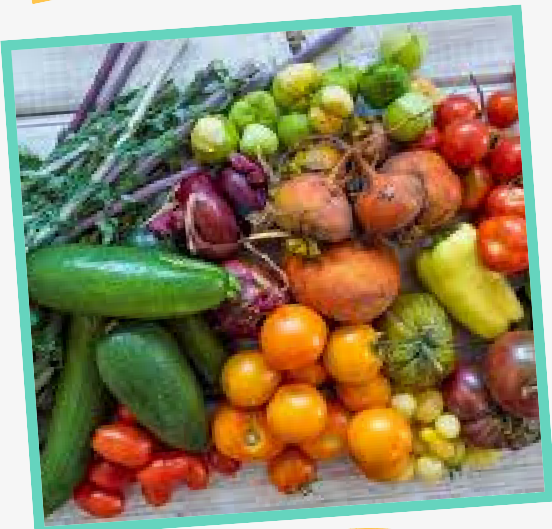
