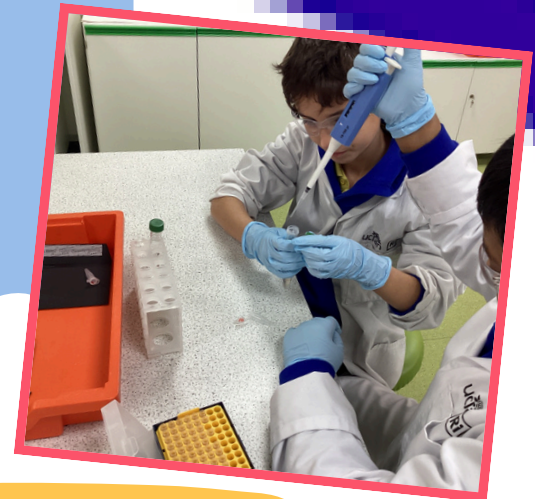

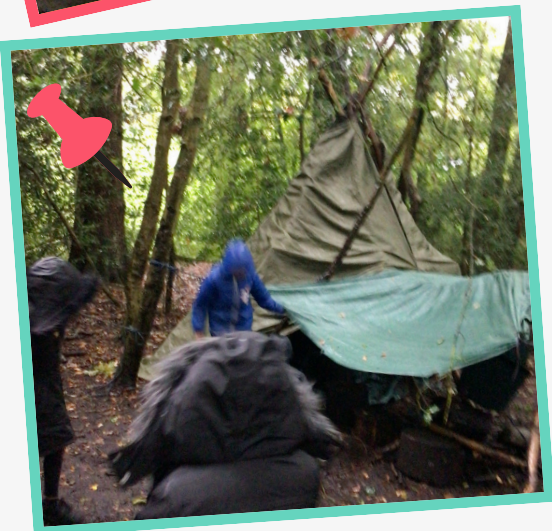
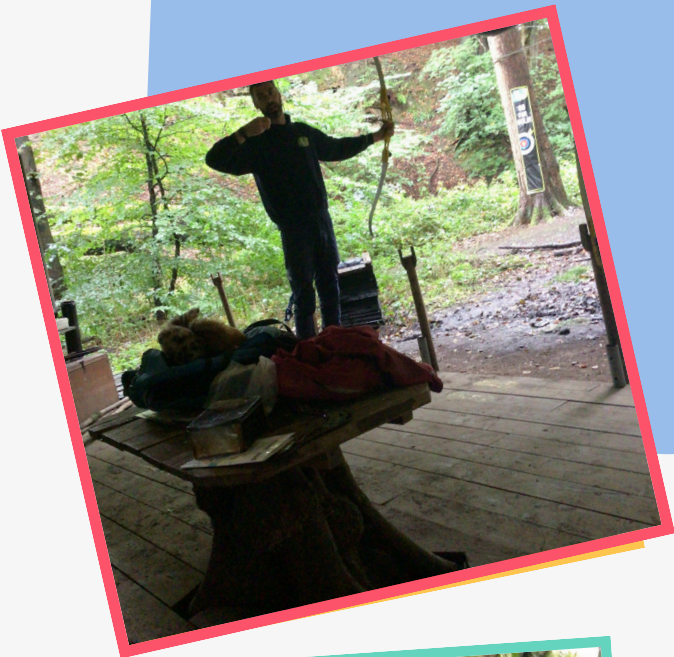


Harvest Festival
